

Centrally sponsored - Accelerated Urban Water Supply Programme
(AUWSP)

Urban water supply scheme is prepared and implemented for the towns having population less than 20,000 souls as per 1991 census under centrally sponsored sharing basis programme i.e Accelerated Urban Water Supply Programme (AUWSP). The financial pattern for the programme is as under.

Central Share	50%
State share	45%
Local body's contribution	05%

There are 127 towns having population less than 20,000 souls. Out of these, 57 towns are getting sufficient water supply facilities and water supply schemes for remaining 70 towns at an estimated cost of Rs.9316.69 lakh are approved by Government of India. Out of 70 schemes, 64 schemes are completed and 6 schemes are under progress at the end of December, 2007.

The schemes are planned to supply water at the rate of 40 to 70 LPCD. The existing urban water supply schemes are augmented and upgraded with required water components like strengthening of source, pump house, Pumping machinery, pumping main , Storage (U/G sump and Elevated Service Reservoir) , distribution network and other ancillary works. After completing the scheme, scheme is handed over to local body for its operation and Maintenance. The house connections are given by local body.
